- Lessons will be held at Mossman Pool and Caravan Park
- Students will be walking to the pool with their class teacher
- Risk Level of participating in 'Swimming in Pools' and 'Walking to the Pool' HIGH
 - Mossman pool will have lifeguards on deck, along with teacher supervision
 - Students will be counted at the start and finish of activity
 - Ice and first aid will be present
- Class teachers Stephen Guthrie (REC121A) and Scott Jeffery (REC121B) will be supervising their classes
- Students will require:
 - o Full school uniform including enclosed shoes
 - Swimwear must have appropriate coverage (front and back of the togs)
 - All students must wear a T-Shirt or sun shirt for the duration of the pool lessons
 - Sunscreen, hat and a water bottle should be brought to every lesson
