The Department of Education is collecting the personal information in this form in order to:

Your student has been selected to represent Mossman State High School to compete at the TCN Athletics Carnival as part of our Sports program. The aim of the activity is to provide students with an opportunity to participate in athletics against schools within the TCN District.

- Event will be held at Barlow Park, Cairns
- Transport will be either private transport OR FNQ Buslines

 - Students must wear seat belts while travelling on the bus
- Students are expected to travel / arrive in full school uniform. If students wish to, they may change into their sports uniform to compete. A singlet will be available to borrow for the day and plain black running bike pants/ shorts

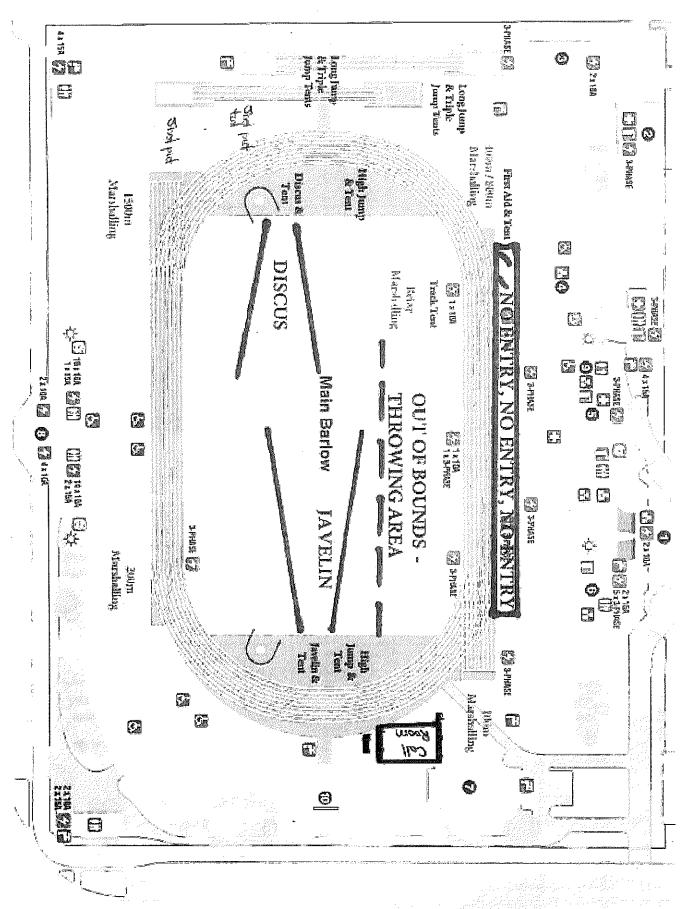
