- Students must travel in full school uniform and enclosed joggers and bring a hat, water bottle, swimming togs, stinger suits (if parents provide), sun shirt, sunscreen and a small backpack.
- Students will be provided with a BBQ Sizzle and popper. They will have the opportunity to purchase additional snack items from the Port Douglas Surf Life Saving club kiosk after lunch.
- For students choosing not to attend, they will be expected to be at school
