<p>Unit 2: Texts and Culture: A Sense of Belonging</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students read the novel, <i>Looking for Alibrandi</i>, by Melina Marchetta and examine its treatment of belonging and identity. Students also study a range of poetry on these themes. They write a short story that draws on an idea presented in one of the texts studied. • Students study the juxtaposition of love and hate in Shakespeare's <i>Romeo and Juliet</i>.
