

SCHOOL EQUIPMENT LIST FOR 2024 YEAR 7

This information is provided so students can successfully undertake their studies. Lack of correct equipment can seriously hamper studies which will in turn be reflected in lower student performance and results. In some cases (eg. practical subjects) it is not possible to cover the course requirements without the proper equipment.

Please ensure that all equipment is <u>CLEARLY NAMED</u> and have some private means of identification placed on them so that losses can be traced. It is required that books be kept in a presentable condition. Parents are encouraged to regularly check student's books for neatness and completion of tasks. Writing should be neat and legible, lines should be ruled, and there should be no scribbling or graffiti on pages.

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

GENERAL EQUIPMENT FOR <u>ALL</u> SUBJECT AREAS

Pencils (HB), eraser, pens (blue/black & red), coloured pencils, glue, scissors, sharpener, ruler – timber or plastic, USB stick, dictionary, thesaurus, 3 pack of highlighters and 1 zipper binder folder.

No liquid paper, correction pen or tape allowed.

Students <u>MUST</u> purchase individual exercise books for subjects rather than one book/folder with dividers.

Scientific calculator – Sharp EL-531THB (these are available from the school office for \$22).

Students will need to purchase printing credit vouchers for \$5 at the start of the year from the office and top up as required.

JAPANESE (JPS)	A4 exercise book.
MATHEMATICS (MAT)	4 x A4 exercise books (one for each term), scientific calculator – Sharp EL-531THB (may be purchased from School Office).
MUSIC (MUS)	Work book provided.
SCIENCE (SCI)	A4 exercise book and scientific calculator – Sharp EL-531THB (may be purchased from School Office).
VISUAL ARTS (ART)	2B, 4B and 6B pencils and black felt tip fine liner pen.

Bring Your Own Device – Laptop (BYOx) is encouraged but not essential in Junior School. If you choose to participate, please see the following information.

Practical tips to consider when buying a new laptop:

- 1. Avoid the bells and whistles when it comes to flip and touch screens etc (less to go wrong).
- 2. Ensure you buy a good quality laptop case and carry bag.
- 3. Do not pay extra for Microsoft Office products including Word, PowerPoint and Excel. We can install and provide free licencing while your child is at school.
- 4. Consider purchasing extended warranty if it is on offer as it is a good idea for portable devices that are constantly on the move.
- 5. Mac is not supported in the school system.

All students will require a personal laptop with the following specifications:	 Windows 10 or 11 – no iPads, tablets, Apple devices or Chromebooks. (This school does not support Apple products) Minimum battery life of 6 hours to cover a school day. NB There will be no charging facilities at school. Minimum of 4GB RAM. Microsoft Office (school can provide free licencing while your child is at school). Wireless networking capacity. Protective case and carry bag. Separate mouse if required by student. Please consider Onsite warranty (Next Business Day (NBD) Onsite warranty is strongly recommended if possible). Accidental Damage Protection Insurance (ADP) preferably from the manufacturer. 	
Enrolment in subjects such as Media, Graphics and Digital, would require a higher specification machine as indicated to run the higher end software.	 i5/i7 processor. 8GB RAM or more. Dedicated graphics card. 500GB Mechanical Hard Drive or 512GB SSD. USB Headphones – any brand. Over-ear may lead to fewer problems in later years.
