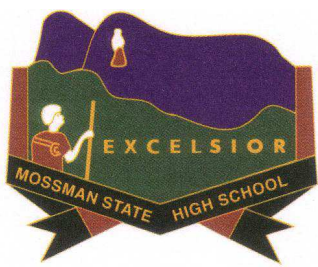
All classes start school on Tuesday, the 28th January 2020

It is required that books be kept in a presentable condition. Parents are encouraged to regularly check student's books for neatness and completion of tasks. Writing should be neat and legible, lines should be ruled, and there should be no scribbling or graffiti on pages.

GENERAL EQUIPMENT FOR <u>ALL</u> SUBJECT AREAS	<p>Pencil (HB), eraser, biros (blue/black & red), coloured pencils, glue, scissors, sharpener, ruler, USB stick, dictionary, thesaurus, and 3 pack of highlighters. 1 zipper binder folder.</p> <p>No liquid paper correction pen or tape allowed.</p> <p>Students MUST purchase individual exercise books for subjects rather than one book/folder with dividers.</p> <p>Scientific calculator – Sharp EL-531THB (these are available from the school office for \$22).</p> <p>Students will need to purchase printing credit vouchers for \$5 at the start of the year from the office and top up as required.</p>

SUBJECT	EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS
ART (ART)	2B, 4B, 6B pencils, black felt tip fine liner pen.
DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY (DIG)	128 page exercise book.
ENGLISH (ENG)	A4 128 page exercise book or folder with lined paper (x 2).
FOOD STUDIES (FDS)	A4 display folder with plastic leaflets and A4 lined paper Basic cooking and sewing materials are provided.
HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION (HPE)	A4 128 page exercise book, hat, drink bottle and sunscreen.
HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES (HUM)	A4 128 page exercise book (x 2).
INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY MANUFACTURING (ITM)	A4 work/manilla folder.
MATHEMATICS (MAT)	A4 128 page exercise book (x 2), Scientific calculator (listed above) 1 packet loose leaf 1mm square grid paper.
MUSIC (MUS)	Work book provided.
SCIENCE (SCI)	A4 128 page Botany Book 8mm rule. One page ruled, one page blank.
