Please ensure that all equipment is **CLEARLY NAMED** and have some private means of identification placed on them so that losses can be traced. It is required that books be kept in a presentable condition.

GENERAL EQUIPMENT FOR <u>ALL</u> SUBJECT AREAS	<p>Pencil (HB), Eraser, Biro's (black, blue & red), Coloured Pencils, Highlighter Pens, Glue, Scissors, Sharpener, Stapler, Ruler, USB Stick, and Scientific Calculator Sharp EL-531XHB (these are available from the school office for \$22.00).</p> <p>Students <u>MUST</u> purchase individual exercise books for subjects rather than one book/folder with dividers.</p> <p>Students will need to purchase printing credit vouchers for \$5 from the office as required.</p>

ENGLISH (ENG)	128 page exercise book.
GRAPHICS (GPH)	A3 Display folder, work folio (available from school).

HOME ECONOMICS (HEC)	A4 display folder, A4 lined paper.

INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGIES (ICT)	128 page exercise book.
MATHEMATICS (MAT)	128 page exercise book per term, protractor, graph paper, A4 display folder, Scientific Calculator Sharp EL-531XHB (purchased from the school office \$22.00).
HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION (HPE)	128 page exercise book, hat, water bottle, and sunscreen.

VISUAL ARTS (ART)	2B, 4B, and 6B pencils, glue, eraser, need 2 fine point black nikko pens 99-L and a correction pen. All specialised materials provided through the Art levy. A2-A3 canvas.

Bring Your Own Device (BYOX) -

Should you wish your student to participate in this program, we would strongly recommend the following minimum specifications for general school use.

- Minimum battery life of 6 hours to cover a school day. NB There will be no charging facilities at school.
- Computer with a minimum of 4GB RAM
- Protective case
- Pointing device (mouse or stylus), touchpad on laptops is ok.
- Onsite warranty [Next Business Day (NBD) Onsite warranty is strongly recommended if possible].
- Accidental Damage Protection Insurance (ADP) preferably from the manufacturer, if done through a third party, check the repair timeframe, next business day if possible is recommended. - *From our experience with NSSCF devices, we consider this essential.*

Enrolment in subjects such as Photography, Film, TV & New Media and Graphics would require a higher specification machine as below to run the higher end software.

- i5 processor (i7 preferred)
- 8GB RAM or more
- Dedicated graphics card
- 500GB Hard drive

In addition, connection to the network will only be possible for machines with a functioning antivirus program installed, a signed BYOX Agreement Charter and connection fee of approximately \$30.
