This information is provided so students can successfully undertake their studies. Lack of correct equipment can seriously hamper studies which will in turn be reflected in lower student performance and results. In some cases (e.g., practical subjects) it is not possible to cover the course requirements without the proper equipment.

Please ensure that all equipment is **CLEARLY NAMED** and have some private means of identification placed on them so that losses can be traced. It is required that books be kept in a presentable condition. Parents are encouraged to regularly check student's books for neatness and completion of tasks. Writing should be neat and legible, lines should be ruled, and there should be no scribbling or graffiti on pages.

GENERAL EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS – will be used for ALL subject areas	
Ruled Exercise Books	Students MUST purchase individual exercise books for subjects rather than one book/folder with dividers.
Stationery	Pencils (HB), eraser, pens (blue, black & red), coloured pencils, glue, scissors, sharpener, ruler – timber or plastic, USB stick, dictionary, thesaurus, 3 pack of highlighters and 1 zipper binder folder. <i>No liquid paper – correction pen/tape allowed.</i>
Calculator	Must be Scientific. e.g., Sharp EL-531THB (these are available from the school office for \$24.00).
Printing Credit	Purchase printing credit vouchers for \$5 at the start of the year from the office and top up as required.
Laptop (BYOx)	Students will need a <u>laptop with Microsoft Office capabilities</u> (Microsoft Office is free downloadable software for all students) NO Chromebooks. See attached Important IT Information

Important IT Information

The Education Queensland preferred model for further integration of Information & Communication Technology (ICT) into the curriculum is Bring Your Own Device (BYOx).

This means that parents are responsible for the provision of personal laptops for their student to use. Class sets of recycled laptops are being phased out as they become unserviceable and will not be replaced.

Mossman State High School has access to a free InTune connection portal to facilitate the connection of these personal devices to the school network. We would strongly recommend the following minimum specifications for general school use.

There is no fee to connect a BYO device to the school network. Windows Defender is an acceptable functioning antivirus program that is freely available in Windows 10 and 11.
